## SWIMMING POOL RULES

a. Swimming will be permitted only between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. (DST).

b. Swimming is at your own risk as there is no life guard.

c. No person having any disease of the eyes, ears, nose, throat, or skin, or any communicable disease will be permitted in the pool.

d. No diving, horseplay, running, pushing, shouting, loud music, or unnecessary splashing will be permitted in

the pool area.

e. No breakable or glass container of any kind will be permitted in the pool area.

f. No animals of any kind are permitted in the pool area, on the pool deck or in the pool.

g. No furniture other than that provided for the pool area will be permitted in the area,

and no furniture provided for the pool area will be removed from the area.

h. Grills are not permitted in the pool area.

i. The gate to the pool area shall be latched when not in use and shall be locked when exiting the pool area if no one else is in the pool area.

j. The pool and pool area are for the exclusive use of owners, occupants and their guests and owners will in all cases be responsible for the conduct of their occupants and their guests, and any damages caused by owners, occupants or their guests must be paid for by the owner.

k. Each unit is limited to 6 guests at the pool area at a time unless prior permission is requested and received from an Officer or Board Member.

I. A homeowner or his designee must accompany guests that are under 16 years old.

m. The maximum number of persons in the pool at any time is 21.

n. If an owner is in arrears of any dues or assessments owed to the Association, the delinquent the owner and his guests and tenants are prohibited from using the pool and other common areas of the Association.

o. Each person is responsible for removing their trash and personal belongings when they depart from the pool area. When the last person departs the pool area, they must tum off any lights and fans and remove any remaining trash.

p. All persons using the pool and pool area will comply with the requests of any Officer or Board member of the Association respecting the matters of personal conduct in and about the pool area.
